



Bournemouth University Juggling Society

Constitution

- The Juggling Society will operate an open membership policy to anyone affiliated with Bournemouth University; regardless of levels of experience within juggling¹, solely upon the signing of individual Risk Assessment declarations.
- Each member, upon arrival at their first practice session, will be required to sign a Risk Assessment Declaration. This will state that the member accepts full responsibility for their actions and understand the inherent risks induced when practicing a juggling discipline. It also states that an adequate full Risk Assessment has been conducted and that Bournemouth University and/or the Juggle Soc Signatories will not be held responsible in the case of injury.
- The Signatories will complete a Risk Assessment ensuring the safety of the practice environment (Talbot House) for both the members of the club and the maintenance of the room.
- For a session to run a minimum of two Signatories must be present in order to exercise an active Risk Assessment during practice.
- No member may participate in practice or performance under the influence of drugs or alcohol; an exemption will be made for members under prescribed medication that does not debilitate the safe practice of a juggling discipline.
- Signatories reserve the right to expel membership from anyone acting abusively or disorderly.

Objective

- To welcome all levels of experience and provide a community wherein the members can practice their discipline, learn from others and contribute to performances as affiliates / representatives of Bournemouth University.

Method of Teaching

- Individual tuition via the exchange of instruction and knowledge of practice between members.
- The provision of instruction books on juggling disciplines will be made available within the club.
- Group workshops whereby an invited performer (either a resident member of the club, or an external guest) will discuss, demonstrate and provide instruction on their skill/discipline to open workshops within the practice sessions.

¹ *Juggling* used as an umbrella term in reference to any performance prop, e.g. poi, staff, devil sticks etc
